Crochet Basket Weave Stitch



DIFFICULTY LEVEL

Easy to Intermediate.

MATERIALS

Yarn

Any DK weight yarn.

Tools

3mm crochet hook.

Tapestry needle.

ABBREVIATIONS

This pattern is written using standard US crochet terminology.

- Ch = Chain(s)
- Dc = Double crochet
- Hdc = Half double crochet
- Bpdc = Back post double crochet
- Fpdc = Front post double crochet
- St(s) = Stitch (es)

Stitch conversion table (UK/US):

UK		US	
Chain	Ch	Chain	Ch
Treble	Tr	Double	Dc
Half treble	Htr	Half double	Hdc

Pattern notes:

- The finished size and the amount of yarn used may vary depending on the individual's gauge.
- If you want to change the final measurements, you can increase / decrease # of starting chains and # of rows until reach the desired length & width.
- Ch2 at the beginning of each row counts as hdc.

METHOD

Start with ch 24. [Multiples of 4]

Row 1: dc in the 4th ch from hook, dc across the row.



Row 2: ch2, turn, *fpdc in the next 4st, bpdc in the next 4st*, repeat * until last 5st, fpdc in the next 4st, hdc in the last st.



Row 3: ch2, turn, *bpdc in the next 4st, fpdc in the next 4st*, repeat * until last 5st, bpdc in the next 4st, hdc in the last st.



Row 4 - 5: repeat row 2.



Row 6: repeat row 3.

Row 7: repeat row 2.



Row 8 - 9: repeat row 3.

Repeat rows 2 - 9 until reach the desired length.

Fasten off, Weave in all ends.
