

# Crochet Stitch Pattern



## DIFFICULTY LEVEL

Intermediate.

## MATERIALS

### Yarn

Any DK weight yarn with 3 different colors.

### Tools

3mm crochet hook.

Tapestry needle.

## TENSION

### Gauge:

In Pattern Stitch, 17 st \* 13 rows = 4" \* 4" (10\*10 cm)

## ABBREVIATIONS

This pattern is written using standard US crochet terminology.

- Ch = Chain(s)
- Dc = Double Crochet
- St(s) = Stitch (es)
- Sc = Single Crochet
- Fpdc = Front Post Double Crochet

### Stitch conversion table (UK/ US):

UK		US	
Chain	Ch	Chain	Ch
Double	Dc	Single	Sc
Treble	Tr	Double	Dc

### Pattern notes:

- The finished size and the amount of yarn used may vary depending on the individual's gauge.
- Ch2 on the beginning of the row counts as first dc.
- Ch1 on the beginning of the row counts as first sc.
- Change color after every 2 rows.
- If you want to change the final measurements, you can increase / decrease # of starting chains and # of rows until reach the desired length & width.

## METHOD

Start with ch 20.

**Row 1:** dc in the 4th ch from hook, \*dc in the next st\*, repeat \* across the remaining chains.

[17st]



**Row 2:** ch2 (counts as first dc), turn, \*fpdc in the next st, dc in the next st\*, repeat \* across the row. [17st]





**Row 3:** ch1 (counts as first sc), turn, sc across the row. [17st]



**Row 4:** change color, ch2, turn, \*dc in the next st, fpdc in the next st 2 rows down\*, repeat \* across until reach the last 2st, dc in the last 2st. [17st]





**Row 5:** ch1, turn, sc across the row. [17st]





**Row 6:** change color, ch2, turn, \*fpdc in the next st 2 rows down, dc in the next st\*, repeat \* across until the end. [17st]



**Row 7:** repeat row 5. [17st]



- Repeat from row 4 – 7 until reach the desired length.

Fasten off, Weave in all ends
