

# Crochet Cluster Stitch



## DIFFICULTY LEVEL

Easy.

## MATERIALS

## Yarn

Any DK weight yarn.

## Tools

3mm crochet hook.

Tapestry needle.

## ABBREVIATIONS

This pattern is written using standard US crochet terminology.

- Ch = Chain(s)
- Sc = Single Crochet
- Dc = Double crochet
- St(s) = Stitch (es)

## Stitch conversion table (UK/ US):

<i>UK</i>		<i>US</i>	
<b>Chain</b>	<b>Ch</b>	Chain	<b>Ch</b>
<b>Double</b>	<b>Dc</b>	Single	<b>Sc</b>
<b>Treble</b>	<b>Tr</b>	Double	<b>Dc</b>

## Pattern notes:

- The finished size and the amount of yarn used may vary depending on the individual's gauge.
- If you want to change the final measurements, you can increase / decrease # of starting chains and # of rows until reach the desired length & width.

## INSTRUCTIONS

Start with any even # of chains, In this tutorial we start with ch 20.

**Row 1:** sc in the 2nd ch from hook, sc in the next st, \*ch1, skip next ch, sc in the next st\*, repeat \* across to the end, sc in the last ch.



**Row 2:** ch4, turn, [yarn over, insert hook in the first space, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops] (2 loops on your hook), repeat [ ] 2 more times in the same space (4 loops on your hook), yarn over, pull through all loops, \*\*ch1, \*yarn over, insert hook in the next space, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops\* (2 loops on your hook), repeat \* 2 more times in the same space (4 loops on your hook), yarn over, pull through all loops\*\*, repeat \*\* across the row until reach the last 2st, ch1, dc in the last st.



**Row 3:** ch3, turn, \*yarn over, insert hook in the first space, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops\* (2 loops on your hook), repeat \* 2 more times in the same space (4 loops on your hook), yarn over, pull through all loops, ch1, \*\*[yarn over, insert hook in the next space, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops] (2 loops on your hook), repeat [ ] 2 more times in the same space (4 loops on your hook), yarn over, pull through all loops, ch1\*\*, repeat \*\* across the row until reach the last space, \*yarn over, insert hook in the last space, pull up a loop, yarn over, pull through 2 loops\* (2 loops on your hook), repeat \* 2 more times (4 loops on your hook) in the same space, yarn over, pull through all loops.



- Repeat previous row until reach the desired length.

Fasten off, Weave in all ends.
