Crochet Star Stitch Pattern

(Stars and Rows)



DIFFICULTY LEVEL

Easy to Intermediate.

MATERIALS

Yarn

Any DK weight yarn with 2 different colors.

Tools

3mm crochet hook.

Tapestry needle.

TENSION

Gauge:

In Pattern Stitch, 12 st * 11 rows = 2.4" * 2.4" (6*6 cm)

ABBREVIATIONS

This pattern is written using standard US crochet terminology.

- Ch = Chain(s)
- Sc = Single Crochet
- BLO = Back Loop Only
- SI St = Slip Stitch
- St(s) = Stitch (es)

Stitch conversion table (UK/US):

UK		US	
Chain	Ch	Chain	Ch
Double	Dc	Single	Sc

Pattern notes:

- The finished size and the amount of yarn used may vary depending on the individual's gauge.
- Ch3 on the beginning of the row doesn't count as first dc.
- Change color after every 2 rows.
- If you want to change the final measurements, you can increase / decrease # of starting chains and # of rows until reach the desired length & width.

METHOD

Start with ch 30.

Row 1: sc in the 2nd ch from hook, *sc in the next st*, repeat * across the remaining chains.

Row 2: ch3, turn, insert hook in 2nd ch from hook, yarn over, pull up a loop, *insert hook in the next ch, yarn over, pull up a loop*, repeat * 3 more times (you should now have 6 loops on your hook), yarn over, pull through all 6 loops, ch1 (this complete first star and make the eye of the star), **Insert hook into the eye of previous star stitch, yarn over, pull up loop, insert hook into last loops star you just made, yarn over, pull up a loop, Insert hook into same st as last loop of previous star, yarn over, pull up loop, Insert hook into next 2 chains, yarn over, pull up loop. (6 loops on hook), Yarn over and pull through all 6 loops, ch 1**, repeat ** until the end, dc in the last st.



Row 3: ch2, turn, sc in the first st, skip next st, *2sc in the next st, skip next st, 2sc in the next st*, repeat * until the end, sc in the last st.

Row 4: change color, ch2, turn, sl st across the row.

Row 5: ch2, turn, working in BLO, sl st across the row until reach the last st, sc in the last st.



Row 6: change color, working in BLO, ch3, turn, insert hook in 2nd ch from hook, yarn over, pull up a loop, *insert hook in the next ch, yarn over, pull up a loop*, repeat * 3 more times (you should now have 6 loops on your hook), yarn over, pull through all 6 loops, ch1 (this complete first star and make the eye of the star), **Insert hook into the eye of previous star stitch, yarn over, pull up loop, insert hook into last loops star you just made, yarn over, pull up a loop, Insert hook into same st as last loop of previous star, yarn over, pull up loop, Insert hook into next 2 chains, yarn over, pull up loop. (6 loops on hook), Yarn over and pull through all 6 loops, ch 1**, repeat ** until the end, dc in the last st.

Row 7: repeat row 3.

Row 8: repeat row 4.

Row 9: repeat row 5.

 \square Repeat from row 6 – 9 until reach the desired length.

Fasten off, Weave in all ends.
